

CODE OF CONDUCT

SUMMER 2022

The 1st West Hoathly Code of Conduct was written by Scouts and Leaders in 2019.

- 1. Respect everyone, property, equipment and time
- 2. Listen to each other
- 3. Be silent when asked
- 4. Avoid bad language, physical contact and bullying behaviour at all times
- 5. Be quiet and sensible during ceremonies and explanations
- 6. Set a good example to those around us
- 7. Be smart, punctual and wear our uniform with pride
- 8. Get involved and give our best effort to all activities
- 9. No mobile phones
- 10. Keep the Scout Promise and the Scout Law
- 11. Have fun!

Due to COVID-19 the following additional elements have been added to the Code of Conduct in 2021.

If national COVID-19 prevention measures are in place:

- 1. Wear a mask and maintain social distancing during drop-off and pick-up
- Do not use the Scout Hut unless given permission by a Leader
- 3. If Scouts use the Hut / toilet then Scouts will wash hands according to Government guidelines
- 4. Maintain social distancing as far as possible during the sessions according to Government guidelines (or 2m) except in an emergency
- 5. Scouts will not attend a meeting if they, or a member of their bubble, are ill with COVID-19 symptoms
- 6. Scouts will inform the Scout Leader if they, or a member of their bubble, present with COVID-19 symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19 up to 20 days after a meeting
- 7. Scouts consent to personal details being passed to NHS Track and Trace if they, or a member of their bubble, becomes ill with COVID-19

Scouts accept that breaches of the Code of Conduct may lead to suspension from the Scout Group.
